## PUBLIC NOTICE

### NOTICE TO OWNERS OF LAND AFFECTED BY THE FINAL HEARING FOR THE WOODS OF GLEN ERIN SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS

All owners of land in the service area of the **Woods of Glen Erin Sanitary Sewer Improvements** are hereby notified that the Delaware County Sanitary Engineer has filed the plans, specifications, estimate of cost, and tentative assessments for the improvement with the Commissioners for their review and consideration.

You are further notified that the Board of County Commissioners of Delaware County has fixed **Thursday, August 13, 2020, at 10:00 A.M.** in the Commissioners' Hearing Room 101 North Sandusky Street Delaware, Ohio as the time and place for the public hearing by the Commissioners on any objections to the proposed improvements, the tentative assessments, or the boundaries of the assessment district. Any owner may appear and offer evidence for or against the proposed improvements, the tentative assessments, or the boundaries of the assessment district.

The proposed improvement will extend sanitary sewer access to 56 parcels located in Concord Township on Sylvian Drive, Serenity Drive and Erin Woods Drive, and at 7639, 7769, and 7801 Harriott Road. A copy of the detailed plans, specifications, cost estimate, and tentative assessments are on file and may be examined by contacting the Delaware County Regional Sewer District at (740) 833-2240.

Any owner that cannot attend the hearing may either have an attorney attend and present on their behalf, or they may file written objections to or endorsements of the proposed improvements, the tentative assessments, or the boundaries of the assessment district prior to the hearing or at any time up through five days following the close of the hearing, in accordance with R.C. 6117.06(E). Owners may also file written requests for deferment of the collection of the assessment at any time up through five days following the close of the hearing, in accordance with R.C. 6117.061. Written objections, endorsements, or requests for deferment should be sent to the following address:
